

The General Account

The income for our General account 2023-24 totalled £2437.13. With our expenses being £2526.25, we had a small deficit of £89.12 leaving us with a closing Balance of £5433.44

Last year we opened a recruitment account to help us be more proactive in finding candidates for our order. We have designed and purchased folded leaflets and postcards to be handed out to Brethren who may be interested in joining. Leaflets are also on display at our Masonic Centres.

The Charity Account
